Description : The component inserts JavaScript code for a browser-language-specific re-direct. Currently supported languages: German, English, Italian, Swedish, French and Russian. You can choose to call the code automatically or manually, as needed.
NOTE: This component works in Netscape v4+ and IE v4+ Browsers!

<u>Properties</u>	<u>Description</u>
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Function-Name : (optional)	Here you enter a name for the JavaScript function. The name will be used to call the function and must be unique for this page. You will need this name when choosing to call the function manually. When left empty, a default-name will be used.
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Call Type :	Choose how to call the function : automatically or manually.
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Use in Autoframes :	With this property you choose if you want to link to Autoframe-pages. In this case and according to the link target some NOF-Autoframe-specific things will be generated.
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Link Target : (optional)	Here you enter the name of the frame or window where the resulting page will be displayed.
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• xxx Browser : (optional)	This link will be used if you have a browser in the language xxx.
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Other Languages than selected : (optional)	This link will be used if your browser-language is different from the languages where you have entered links above.
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• No v4-Browser : (optional)	This link will be used if the user don't have an v4-browser (Netscape or IE).
