

# NFX-Datasheet

**Component :** BrowserLanguageRedirect

**Version :** 5.11 | NOF 2/3  NOF 4/5

**Description :** The component inserts JavaScript code for a browser-language-specific re-direct. Currently supported languages: German, English, Italian, Swedish, French and Russian. You can choose to call the code automatically or manually, as needed.  
**NOTE:** This component works in Netscape v4+ and IE v4+!

<u>Properties</u>	<u>Description</u>
• <b>Wizard :</b>	Double-Click this property to open the wizard or choose the Wizard-Tab you want to see first.
• <b>Function-Name :</b> (optional)	Here you enter a name for the JavaScript function. The name will be used to call the function and must be <b>unique</b> for this page. You will need this name when choosing to call the function manually. When left empty, a default-name will be used.
• <b>Call Type :</b>	Choose how to call the function : automatically or manually.
• <b>Use in Frames :</b>	With this property you choose if you want to link to Autoframe-pages. In this case and according to the link target some NOF-Autoframe-specific things will be generated.
• <b>Link Target :</b> (optional)	Here you enter the name of the frame or window where the resulting page will be displayed.
• <b>xxx Browser :</b> (optional)	This link will be used if you have a browser with the language xxx.
• <b>Other Languages than selected :</b> (optional)	This link will be used if your browser-language is different from the languages where you have entered links above.
• <b>No v4-Browser :</b> (optional)	This link will be used if the user don't have an v4-browser (Netscape or IE).
• <b>Use Custom-HTML :</b>	Here you choose if the Custom-HTML entered in the Wizard is inserted when publishing or not.
